The International Transnational Education Association (ITEA) was founded in 2022 and officially launched during the "Opening Ceremony of 2022 China-ASEAN Education Cooperation Week", which was co-hosted by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of China, the Ministry of Education of China, and the People's Government of Guizhou Province. ITEA was subsequently registered in the United Kingdom in the same year.

ITEA is a collaborative initiative that brings together various organizations, institutions, government agencies and alliances in the field of transnational education. Established with the goal of promoting cooperation, knowledge exchange, and enhancing the quality and sustainability of transnational education programs globally, ITEA has evolved into a global network comprising universities, colleges, government agencies and educational organizations engaged in transnational education initiatives.

Organizational Structure of ITEA





- Awards may be presented to individuals, institutions, or initiatives that have demonstrated excellence, innovation, and leadership in advancing transnational education.


